Introduction, Allocation, Sport Development & Accountability :

At Great Finborough Primary School we welcome the additional funding provided by the DfE to support the development of school sport. This plan identifies the work we undertake, and are undertaking, to ensure that **every child** has access to a high quality Sport curriculum both during the school day and through extra-curricular sporting opportunities.

In addition to this plan, we also operate a separate budget plan, enabling us to clearly track the expenditure in this area of the curriculum. A copy of the budget spreadsheet is available from the school office on request.

We have recently gained the Sainsbury's School Games Silver Award in recognition of our work in the area of sport over the previous 12 months. As part of the Sainsbury School Games award and recognition system, we are required to track pupil participation in lessons, extra-curricular sport activities, intra-school events, inter-school events, officiating and leadership. An anonymised version of this document is also available from the school office on request. This year we are aiming to maintain our 'Silver Award', and in order to achieve this we need to ensure sustainability of all existing work and opportunities and then to further develop sport leadership. We are also continuing with both a Young Sports Leader scheme and a Sports Council.

Allocation:

The DfE provide schools a block grant of £8,000 and then an additional £5.00 per head for every child in years 1-6.

Our allocation this year is: **£8,570.00**

As a school we also supplement this income from our main delegated budget.

Sport Development:

Schools are given freedom on how they spend the money to improve the quality of PE and Sport opportunities but the basic principles for the use of the funding are defined by the DfE as follows:

- hire specialist PE teachers
- hire qualified sports coaches to work with teachers
- provide existing staff with teaching resources to help them teach PE and sport
- support and involve the least active children by running or extending school sports clubs, holiday clubs and [Change4Life](#) clubs
- run sport competitions or increase pupils' participation in the [School Games](#)
- run sports activities with other schools.
