3a	Use a combination of materials that are cut, torn and glued.			
3b	Sort and arrange materials.			
3c	Mix materials to create texture.			
3d	Use a combination of shapes.			
3e	Include lines and texture.			
3D 4				
4a	Use rolled up paper, straws, paper, card and clay as materials.			
4b	Use techniques such as rolling, cutting, moulding and carving.			
Drawing 5				
5a	Draw lines of different sizes and thickness.			
5b	Colour (own work) neatly following the lines.			
5c	Show pattern and texture by adding dots and lines.			
5d	Show different tones by using coloured pencils.			
Printing 6				
6a	Use repeating or overlapping shapes.			
6b	Mimic print from the environment (e.g. wallpapers).			
6c	Use objects to create prints (e.g. fruit, vegetables or sponges).			
6d	Press, roll, rub and stamp to make prints.			
Textiles 7				
7a	Use weaving to create a pattern.			
7b	Join materials using glue and/or a stitch.			
7c	Use plaiting.			
7d	Use dip dye techniques.			



7e	Use a wide range of tools to create different textures, lines, tones, colours and shapes.			
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
