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COVID Recovery: During lockdown there was a good uptake of the MFL Home Learning. The packs issued via Google Classroom included links to videos to help with the pronunciation of key vocabulary and phrases. The children were provided with songs and games to encourage their speaking and listening skills. Writing activities were built in to develop their literacy skills, building from labelling to writing sentences. Key vocabulary was provided for all units of work. The Home Learning units of work built on their previous learning.

The progress through the units of work is carefully tracked and it has been decided that the children will continue to follow those units of work to ensure progression, the units of work will be adapted to focus on the key skills we wish to the children to develop within the time available to us. We have noted the guidance issued by the DFE in July 2021- Teaching a Broad and Balanced Curriculum for Education Recovery.
